The Australian Cropping industry includes wheat and other grains, oilseeds, pulses, rice, sugar, cotton and seeds.

The Cropping industries provide a significant contribution to the national economy. The grains and oilseeds industry (subject to seasonal variation) produces about 35-45 million tonnes of grain per annum from an area of more than 20 million hectares, with an annual gross value of production (GVP) of around A\$9-13 billion.

Sugar and cotton are also major contributors with a gross value of production exceeding \$1 and \$2 billion respectively.
