The Dairy industry is the 3rd largest rural industry in Australia and a key sector of the agricultural economy, generating close to \$4.9 billion in the 2021/22 financial year.

The Australian Dairy Herd totals 1.34 million cows across 4,420 dairy farms averaging a herd size of 303 cows. Australian Dairy provides a Total Annual Milk Production of 8,554 million litres with an average annual milk production per cow of 6,203 litres. This milk produces several main commodities including 408,246 tonnes of Cheese, 192,623 tonnes of Milk powders and 73,019 tonnes of Butter.

Australians consume 15kg cheese and 93litres of milk annually. We also export 36% of our milk production and are currently ranked fourth in terms of world dairy trade with a 5% share, behind New Zealand, the European Union and the United States.

Did vou know?

- Victoria is Australia's largest dairy producing state, producing 5.62 billion litres of milk in 2019-20 - close to two thirds of Australia's milk production
- Gross value of milk produced in Victoria was \$3.0 billion in 2019-20, an increase of \$330 million (up 12%) on the previous year. Milk accounted for 17% of Victoria's gross value of agricultural of production of \$17.8 billion
- Dairy industry is Victoria's second largest agricultural industry after horticulture (\$3.60 billion)
- It is estimated that approximately 8,100 persons work on farms that produce milk in the year to May 2021
