## CAREERS ACCORDING TO EDUCATION & SKILLS

The range of careers across the sheep meat and wool industry is incredibly diverse.

Entry point careers include roles in stock handling and carcass processing.

With increasing experience, skills and training roles can include:

### EDUCATION & TRAINING

1

Year 10, Senior Secondary Certificate of Education, Certificate I or II

*Apprenticeships may be offered at this level*

2

Certificate III, Certificate IV or at least three years relevant experience

*Apprenticeships or Traineeships may be offered at this level*

3

Diploma or Advanced Diploma (undertaken through TAFEs or RTOs)

*Some universities offer studies at this level*

4

Bachelor Degree or higher qualification (often undertaken at a university)
